Special Projects Manager Charles Frazier updated the Board on the current special projects within the park system.

1. Creekside Trail:
  - Repaired two erosion issues west of Beaver Creek Station.
2. Xenia-Jamestown Connector: Completed culvert repairs west of Hogeye rd.
  - Completed brush removal on path.
3. OET: Completed brush removal on path.
4. WBHP: Completed brush Removal on path.
5. Pearl's Fen: Installed a gravel trail from parking lot to the new boardwalk and trailhead.
  - All approvals are in place to demo the house.
6. Hobson: graded and added stone to drive way.

**Other Business**

Mr. Dobney stated the Rangers are working a staggered schedule during the Covid-19 Pandemic. And that the Maintenance Department is working 3 people a day to maintain our Parks due to the current situation.

Mr. Dobney also stated there was graffiti found on the Jamestown Connector and will be cleaned up ASAP.

Mr. Dobney stated Earth Day festivities had been cancelled, and that we had 800 volunteers signed up to help. Also 1200 trees were healed in at Russ Nature Reserve.





Mr. Dobney stated Story Time on Facebook is doing really well. In addition, the Virtual Easter Egg Hunt on Facebook had many people joining in the fun.
