### **Project Update:**


1. Campground at Caesar Ford Park:
  - Phase I 12 full hook up sites, show rendering
  - Online Registration
  - Self-Check-in when arrived
  - Phase II will be 44 more electric sites
  - Will bid through Bid Express (Through Park District)
  - Larry Rancour- Hired Project Manager
  - Phase I will be bid in 2 bids
  - Future expansion is possible
2. Bike Trail Update:
  - Ohio to Erie Trail paving has started at the Clark County Line (Chillicothe Road)
3. Spring Lakes Bridge:
  - There has been a delay in work due to an abutment issue on the park side. Work is to resume soon.
4. Phillips Park:
  - Getting quotes to repair rotten wood on barn. We have quotes to stain barn after the repairs are finished.
5. Pearl's Fen Buffer:
  - Beaver Creek Wetlands Association has Clean Ohio funds left on the Pearl's Fen Buffer Grant. We have gotten a quote for them to install a fence on the Waterford Landing border.


There being no further business to conduct, Commissioner Firley adjourned the meeting at 12:26 p.m.
