- 2. Xenia Jamestown Connector: Culvert repair has been completed.
- 3. Phillips Bridge Abutment Installation: Scheduled but weather is delaying.
- 4. Narrows Parking Lot Expansion: Delayed due to weather.
- 5. Mill Bridge Canoe Launch: Completed a 100' driveway mill and replaced section due to potholes and base issues.
- 6. Bike Trail Wayfinding Signage Project: Update faded and outdated signage.
- 7. Beavercreek Schools Shared Use Path Project: Starting in mid-August.
